INTRODUCTION:


During the academic year 2021-22 the feedbacks were collected from all the participant of the institution. All these feedbacks were analysed by using a five point rating scale. The maximum score is 5 and the minimum score is 1, where 5 indicates highly satisfied, 4 means satisfied, 3 indicates neutral, 2 indicates dissatisfied and 1 indicates highly dissatisfied.

STUDENTS' FEEDBACK (ARTS FACULTY)

Total 429 responses were collected from the students of Arts faculty. The following points were noticed while analysing the alumni feedback for the academic year 2021-22:

- The students have less satisfied that the curriculum has ability to foster entrepreneurship (the scores obtained are 3.8/5)
- The students also feel that the present curriculum has less ability to support higher education. The score given by students are (3.9/5)
- The students are moderately satisfied with the availability of reference books available in the college library. The score given by students for this aspect is (3.8/5)
- The students are also satisfied with the quality of teaching imparted by the teachers in the college. The corresponding score are (3.9/5)
- According to most of the students the present syllabus is career-oriented.
 (3.9/5)
- Moreover, it is also revealed that the students are highly satisfied with relevance of the content of courses because the corresponding score are (4.3/5)
- The overall academic atmosphere of the college is satisfactory to most of students. The overall teaching-learning process was hampered by Corona situation during the year. The score given by them is (3.8/5)






STUDENTS' FEEDBACK (COMMERCE FACULTY)

About 400 feedbacks were collected from Commerce faculty which comprises B. Com. and M. Com. The following points were noticed while analyzing the alumni feedback for the academic year 2021-22:

- The students have satisfaction in the job relevance of the course content (the scores obtained are 4.3/5)
- Most of the students are contented with the quality of teaching. The score given by students are (4.0/5)
- However, they also have the opinion that curriculum has moderately low ability to promote entrepreneurial skills of the students. The score given by students for this aspect is (4.0/5)
- The students are also moderately satisfied with capacity of curriculum in supporting students in their higher studies as per the observation of students. The corresponding score are (3.9/5)
- According to most of the students the present syllabus is career-oriented. (4.1/5)
- Moreover, it is also revealed that the students are contented with the reference books and materials available in the college. The corresponding score are (4.0/5)
- The overall academic atmosphere of the college is satisfactory to most of students. The score given by them is (3.9/5)



ALUMNI FEEDBACK :


The feedbacks were collected from the alumni of the College.

- The academic atmosphere of the college was good which received the score 4.4/5.
- The score obtained for the availability of reference materials is 4.5 which indicates that the alumni are highly satisfied with the reference materials available in the college.



- It is also revealed that curriculum provided in the college nurtures entrepreneurial skills of the student as the score obtained is 4.2/5.




Alumni Feedback (Science faculty) :

Due to Corona situation, there was no any change or updation of any course of any programme. Therefore, no feedback was collected from the teachers.


PARENT FEEDBACK

- The admission process followed by the institution is considered appropriate by most of the parents. It is has obtained a high score of 4.0/5
- Most of the parents are of the opinion that the curriculum-related activities planned by the institution are helpful to their children (4.0/5).
- It is also noted that most the parents are having a good opinion about the accessibility of the text and reference books given in the syllabus. The score obtained is 3.9/5. They are satisfied.
- 3.9/5 is the score given for quality and relevance of courses prescribed in the curriculum indicating the high satisfaction of parents in courses offered by the institution.
- Regarding the accessibility of infrastructure and laboratory facilities (4.0/5), it is found that a great number of parents are satisfied with them.
- Similarly, it is also noted workload in courses offered is considered quite adequate by most. The score is 3.8/5
- 4.0/5 is value obtained for library facilities signifying that most of parents are satisfied in this aspect.
- The student counselling activities are given a score of 4.1/5 indicating that parents are satisfied in these services provided by the teachers.
- Most of the parents are contented with the use of information and communication technology in course delivery (4.0/5).
- The overall academic atmosphere of the institution is given value of 4.2/5 which indicates that the parents are highly satisfied with the discipline, teaching and other activities undertaken in the institution.
- The value obtained for improvement in soft skill through curriculum is 4.1/5 indicating the high satisfaction of parents in the soft skill improvement of the students.
- It is also observed that the ethics and morality of their children had improved considerably through the curriculum delivery mechanism adopted in the institution. The score is 4.2/5
- Most are also satisfied with the examination system followed in the college (4.1/5).
- Majority have the opinion that the evaluation process is highly transparent and the feedback mechanism currently followed by the institution is quite appropriate. It is given a high score of 4.3/5.




EMPLOYERS' FEEDBACK :

- Majority of the employers are of the opinion that the curriculum has less relevance to industrial needs. It has got score 3.4/5.
- They also feels that the curriculum lacks in promoting leadership qualities (3.2/5).
- The curriculum is not much impressive to ensures professional ethics and attitude among the students (3.1/5).
- The soft-skills provided by the curriculum and institution are insufficient to keep up with the requirement of industries (3.3/5).
- They also opined that the curriculum lacks in promoting team-work mentality. It has got score 3.4/5.
- The employers feel that the curriculum enhances problem solving mentality and ability to innovate but is not up to the mark (3.2/5).
- The present students have less mentality regarding inclination to adopt new methods and technology (3.3/5).
